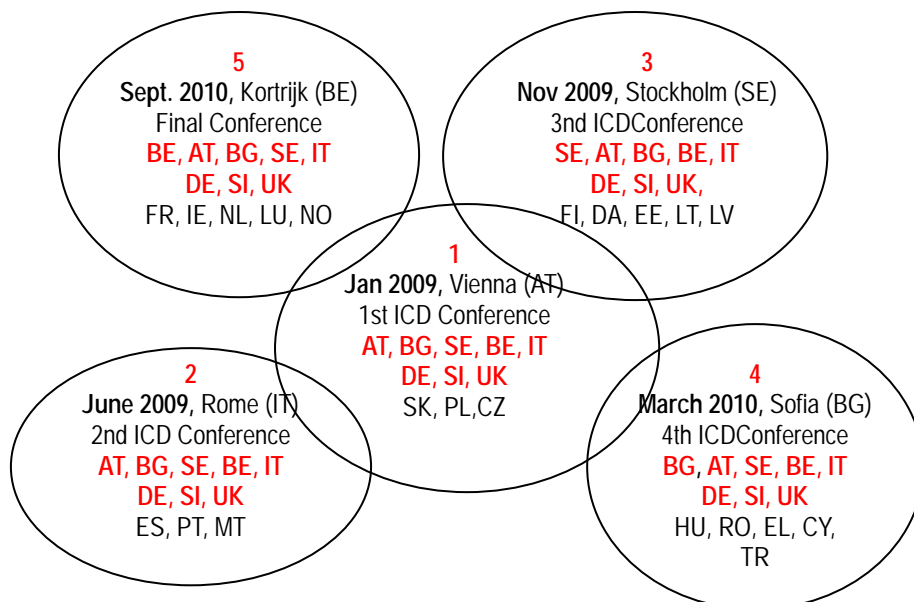


ICD-Conferences in Detail

The project consortium jointly developed, tested and evaluated a model of “Intercultural Dialogue Conferences” (ICD) as a branded tool, which shall help to create pathways for adult learners to improve their knowledge about the EU and their intercultural and key competences via Adult Education Agencies. Learner-centred approaches and use of art and culture as intermediaries provide a rich methodology to motivate learners’ activities, to raise their self-confidence and support creative expression, communication and intercultural exchange. Five regional ICD-Conferences involved participants via partners’ regional/national networks and experts from all 27 EU member states (plus Norway and Turkey).
